Access to Justice- Under an initiative of "Child Marriage-Free India" Yuva Rural Association is creating awareness about Child Protection Laws in Latur and Washim districts.

Highlights

As part of this campaign, a candle march and a pledge-taking ceremony were organized, where over 1043 participants pledged to stand against child marriage. Additionally, the campaign's inauguration included a separate pledge-taking event with 279 participants, emphasized their commitment to eradicating child marriage.

During these events, a short film titled "Liked Sisters" was shown to raise awareness about the negative impacts of child marriage and inspire communities to act. These efforts aimed to build a united movement for a child marriage-free society.






WASH - Water, Sanitation, Health & Hygiene
